

MoU on Geosciences Cooperation Between GSB and China Geological Survey (CGS)

The China Geological Survey (CGS) of the Ministry of Land and Resources of the People's Republic of China and Energy represented by the DDG,CGS and Mineral Resources Division of the Ministry of Power, Energy and Mineral Resources represented by the DG, Geological Survey of Bangladesh (GSB) signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) for future cooperation for future joint investigations and technical exchange in the fields of scientific research related to exploration methods and technology; mineral resources, geological hazards; GIS, geo-tourism and agricultural geology and other related geo-scientific subjects. The MoU makes the passage open for both the organizations and country to share the expertise and views for future geo-scientific research.

The MoU signed between Geological Survey of Bangladesh (GSB) and China Geological Survey (CGS) on 21.09.2017 at the Xi'an Center of China Geological Survey, Xi'an City. The Director General of GSB Mr. Reshad Md. Ekram Ali and Dr. Li Jinfa Deputy Director General of CGS signed the MoU on behalf of the respective organizations. This occasion occurred during an international conference, held from 20-23 September, where representatives of 11 countries from the central and south-east Asia were present there.
